The Event - Josiah's Bicycle Engineering Challenge

Josiah is a 9 year old boy who was born with no arms. His dream was to ride around on a bike with his mates. Dreamfit Foundation has developed an engineering program that will turn Josiah's dream into a reality.

How is this Possible? With sponsorship and mentoring from Engineering Companies, six UWA Engineering Student teams have been selected as finalists in the competition to design and build a bicycle for Josiah. The teams will unveil their designs at the IDPWD breakfast where a judging panel will select the winning team and present that bike to Josiah.

The International Component. The remaining five bicycles will be presented to Frank Surgener, President of Ride Aid Cambodia. These bicycles will be delivered to Cambodian children who have lost limbs through land-mines and birth defects.

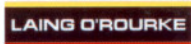
